

**ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** came before the Court on a Petition for Action on Conditions of Release. The Court held a hearing on the petition on June 30, 2006. Counsel for both parties were present, along with Defendant. Defendant was advised of his constitutional rights regarding the petition, waived said rights, and admitted to violation of his conditions of release. Both counsel for the government and Defendant's Pre-Trial Service officer recommended that Defendant's conditions of release be revoked. The Court, having heard the arguments of counsel, the recommendation from Pre-Trial Services, and being otherwise fully advised, **FINDS** that the Defendant violated his conditions of release and that the conditions of release previously ordered should be revoked.

**WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Defendant's Conditions of Release previously set on February 28, 2006, shall be **REVOKED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Defendant shall remain in the custody of the United States Marshals during the pendency of this case.
