ORDER AMENDING CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the unopposed motion of Defendant DANUEL DEAN QUAINANCE for amendment of the conditions of his release, and Mr. Quaintance’s Second Unopposed Motion for Amendment of Conditions of release. The Court, having reviewed the Motions, being aware of the positions of the parties and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, is of the opinion that the Motions are well taken and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the conditions of Mr. Quaintance’s pretrial release be and are hereby amended to delete the requirement of a third party custodian for Mr. Quaintance. Laythol Wayne Quaintance is hereby released from the obligations imposed upon him as third party custodian.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Quaintance’s conditions of release are amended to permit his travel within the state of Arizona and to New Mexico to meet with counsel or attend court proceedings; and such other travel within the United States as permitted in the discretion of Pretrial Services.
