

THIS MATTER, having come before the Court upon Amended Defendant's Second Motion to Modify Conditions of Release, the Court taking note that the Government and Pretrial Services are unopposed to the granting of this Order, and the Court otherwise advised in the premises; **FINDS**: that the motion is well taken and will be granted.
