ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the unopposed motion of Defendant DANUEL DEAN QUAINANCE for continuance of trial setting in this cause. The Court, having reviewed the Motion, being aware of the positions of the parties and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, is of the opinion that the Motion is well taken and should be granted.
